
CULL COW MANUAL

INTRODUCTION

This is a simple program to use but one which you will find invaluable in helping you to decide when to cull cows from your dairy herd.

INDEX PAGE

This is what you will see on your screen when you switch on. It's the index to the Farmfax Dragon Cullcow Program, just like the index to a book.

In fact you will find that the program is as easy as reading a book.

To turn the pages, simply press the same number on the keyboard as the page you wish to refer to.

Let's turn to page 1. (Press Key 1.)

PAGE 1

The first question the Farmfax Dragon is asking is the month and year you wish to consider selling/buying culls. Type out your answer. This will appear alongside the blinker box at the bottom of the page. When you are sure it is correct press the Enter key. This moves the month and year into the black cursor box. Now move this cursor to the right by pressing key so that it sits under the Interest heading and enter the appropriate Bank interest rate using the same procedure as before.

Now carry on completing the columns for milk price, milk yield and total cost of keeping each cow, for every month you

wish to consider. The cost may be purchased foods only, or you may wish to include an estimate for the grass that you could have made into hay.

Finally if the cows are in calf enter the calf value and month of calving. When you have

done all this press the **Break** key and turn the page back to the index. Now press Key 2 to turn to Page 2

PAGE 2

The first question to answer on this page is whether you are buying or selling. Type in 'B' for buying or 'S' for selling and press the **Enter**] key.

Next you will see you are being asked how many cows in the batch. Type the appropriate number out and enter as before. The cursor is now sitting under the Expected Price column. Here you enter how much you would expect to receive (or pay) for each cow and then move the cursor to the right and enter the month. Complete this information for the months you wish to consider by moving the cursor into the various column positions with the directional kevs.

The Farmfax Dragon will now compare your choices by carrying out a complex calculation using all the information you have fed it on page 1. An asterix in the lefthand column will tell you the best offer.




The right hand column will show you the total difference between the price you expected to receive (or pay) and the price actually needed.

If you make a mistake in typing your question press the — key. This will delete letter by letter as the blinker box moves to the left.

Don't worry if there is something in the cursor box when you are answering a Farmfax Dragon question. The answer you type out will replace whatever is there as soon as you press the Enter key.

The zero symbol on the Dragon Keyboard is \emptyset .

When you make an entry under the 'Interest Rate', 'Litres/Day' or 'Cost/ Month' columns you will find that the same figures will automatically appear for the following months. This is to save you time. If you think the interest rate, for example is going to change in a later month, enter the appropriate figure by moving the cursor box into position.
